

A tag must be affixed to each camping structure

Rules for camping

- The camping structures of all people registered to camp under this tag must occupy only one site and be no more than 3 m apart.
- Preferably use a fuel stove. If fires are permitted, use the fireplaces provided.
- Consider other campers. Share facilities.
- Keep noise to a minimum; observe noise curfews.
- Never leave food or drinks unsecured.
- Store rubbish in your vehicle or in bins where provided.
- In recreation areas, camping within 50 m of a lake or water course is prohibited unless camping in a developed campground, or campsite marked with a 'camping allowed' symbol.

Be aware of the environment

- Native plants and animals are protected. Feeding dangerous animals, attracting them with food or disturbing them in any way is an offence.
- Don't use soaps, detergents or shampoos within 50 m of watercourses, creeks or lakes.
- If camping without toilets, bury toilet waste in a hole at least 15 cm deep away from water and public facilities. (beach camping only)

For your safety

- Read and observe information and signs about the area you are visiting
- Adults should always supervise children and walk only in groups.
- Take care when swimming in water holes, dams, creeks, rivers, lakes or the ocean.
